## THE CHURCH ON CREMATION

IN 1963, THE CATHOLIC CHURCH LIFTED ITS BAN ON CREMATION. CREMATION IS PERMITTED PROVIDING THAT THE REASONS FOR CHOOSING CREMATION ARE NOT CHOSEN IN DENIAL OF CHRISTIAN TEACHING ON THE RESURRECTION AND THE SACREDNESS OF THE HUMAN BODY.

ALTHOUGH CREMATION IS PERMITTED, CATHOLIC TEACHING CONTINUES TO STRESS THE PREFERENCE FOR BURIAL OR ENTOMBMENT OF THE BODY OF THE DECEASED. THIS IS DONE IN IMITATION OF THE BURIAL OF JESUS' BODY.

SHOULD A CATHOLIC OPT FOR CREMATION, THE CREMATED REMAINS OF A BODY ARE TO BE BURIED OR ENTOMBED, PREFERABLY IN A CATHOLIC CEMETERY. SCATTERING REMAINS, DIVIDING REMAINS AND KEEPING CREMATED REMAINS AT HOME ARE NOT CONSIDERED REVERENT DISPOSITIONS.

A HOST OF OPTIONS FOR FINAL DISPOSITION OF CREMATED REMAINS ARE AVAILABLE AT CATHOLIC CEMETERIES.

## WHAT ARE MY OPTIONS?

- 1) Entombment of remains in a Cremation Niche (Glass Front, Granite, Marble or Mosaic). These options are available in both indoor and outdoor community Mausolea.
- 2) Traditional in-ground burial of cremation urn.
